NAMI Basics	A 6-session course for parents, guardians and other family caregivers who provide care for youth (age 22 or younger) who are experiencing mental health symptoms. This course is also available in Spanish, Bases y Fundamentos de NAMI.
NAMI Family-to-Family	A 12-session course for families, significant others and friends of people with mental health conditions. The course is designed to facilitate a better understanding of mental health conditions, increase coping skills and empower participants to become advocates for their family members. This program was designated as an evidence-based program by SAMHSA. The course is also available in Spanish, De Familia a Familia de NAMI.
NAMI Homefront	A 6-session course for families, caregivers and friends of military service members and veterans with mental health conditions. The course is designed specifically to help these families understand those challenges and improve their ability to support their service member or veteran.

<p>NAMI Peer-to-Peer</p>	<p>A 8-session course for adults with mental health conditions. The course is designed to encourage growth, healing and recovery among participants. This program is also available in Spanish, De Persona a Persona de NAMI.</p>
<p>NAMI Provider</p>	<p>A class for mental health professionals. NAMI Provider is designed to expand the participants' compassion for the individuals and their families and to promote a collaborative model of care. Either a one-time 4-hour seminar or 5-session course.</p>
<p>NAMI Family & Friends</p>	<p>90 min. seminar that informs and supports people who have loved ones with a mental health condition. Participants learn about diagnosis, treatment, recovery, communication strategies, crisis preparation and NAMI resources.
